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
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Where we are located:

The global payroll, HR and services market value in 2020 is expected to double to \$42bn by 2026. That's a lot of payroll!

The payroll process is structured, yet requires flexibility to deal with a myriad of changes on a weekly or monthly basis. No two payrolls are the same but a professional payroller can identify the most efficient way to minimise tax outlay for the employee and the employer. It is a regular task, providing great job satisfaction while supporting work colleagues and their families. It's constantly changing and evolving as it moves from including hours worked

The Graduate Programme

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When we employ team members, no matter how experienced they may be, we invest in training them to do payroll the "Paycheck Plus Way".

We currently have an opportunity on our Graduate Programme for suitable students or post-grads. Over a three year period, the successful applicants will combine study for the IPASS or CIPP qualification with on-the-job training.

STAGE 1

Starting in our "Lite" Department, you'll gain an understanding of the basics of payroll, employment law and practical guidance on processing payroll on software applications.

Together with your dedicated mentor, you will be able to apply your learning in a practical way working alongside our team of qualified and experienced payroll technicians in the Lite Team. You will learn the basic principles of employment law and how they apply to payroll; the operations of Revenue, how to register an employer or an employee for the first time, the information Revenue requires from Employers. You will gain an understanding of the operation and calculation of PAYE, PRSI, USC and LPT.

The practical training on the in-house software will include training on setting up an employer and employees and enter basic payroll details to arrive at gross pay. You will have the opportunity to import employee tax certificates, upload revenue returns and submit details of starters and leavers. The

fundamental calculations of the various additions and deductions will then take you to a net pay figure so you will be producing and distributing payslips within weeks.

From the commercial aspect, you will gain experience of client relationship and management, work flow processes and management, data protection including the new GDPR requirements and actively participate in the day to day running of a busy office environment.

At the same time, we will sponsor your student registration, college and exam fees to attend IPASS Classes, either at a location near you or on-line. Stage 1 requires 10 weeks of classroom / on-line classes followed by an external exam. Reviews and development milestones within our payroll processing department will be combined with exam results for continuity onto Stage 2.

STAGE 2

As you develop your classroom and on-the-job learning, you will gain practical experience in year-end procedures, larger and more complex payrolls as you partake in the second set of classes for another 10 weeks covering additional employment legislation (including for example, Maternity, Paternity and other statutory leave) and payroll calculations for the application of Benefit-in-kind, Pensions and PRSA, PRD, Court Orders, expenses and tax free payment.

At this stage you should be confident in applying the academic learning in the practical environment as you progress to working with our Payroll Specialist Team who look after our Managed Payroll Service. You will have training and experience on the

workings of other payroll software solutions for different company and sector types. You will also gain experience in some project management, financial reporting, analytics and other business management skills.

The second external exam takes place towards the end of your first year with us. Successful completion of the exams will provide you with the IPASS Certified Payroll Technician (CPT) qualification. The IPASS qualification provides payroll personnel with a national recognised QQI qualification and is the "must-have" for professional payroll positions today.

STAGE 3

As you enter your second year with your qualification, if you have successfully completed the necessary in-house progression milestones you will receive a salary increase and sponsorship for the Diploma in Payroll Management which includes registration, course fees and exam fees.

This challenging but rewarding course is also QQI accredited. The course is available through classroom tuition or distance learning and consists of four separate modules covering Advanced payroll calculations, IT & Technical knowledge, Team Management and HR. Successful students can use the designatory letters MIPA after their name.

As you progress through the Diploma, you will be supported by your Paycheck Plus mentor who will help you in a practical and friendly way.

Our objective is for you to succeed and we will work with you in a theoretical and practical hands-on approach combined with classroom tutorials, webinars, industry updates, in-house and off-site training while applying your learning within our working environment.

STAGE 4

Stage four enables you continue your professional development with a further year on the job working with more complex payrolls. This provides you with the opportunity to engage in more challenging payrolls across a range of companies and sectors.

At the end of Stage Four, you can continue on or advance even further to become one of our highly valued Payroll Consultants.


